#### Class # 3 The Number 7 / From Creation to Revelation

INTRO-

Last week, we undertook a careful study of the structure and format of the six days of Creation, in an attempt to show how it highlights the theme and meaning of God creating Man in His image - "b'tzelem Elokim" - and then to show how it may explain many of the laws of shabbat.

In today's class we continue our study to explain how and why the number 7 emerges both in the Flood story and at Har Sinai- and how it explains the first shabbat that Am Yisrael experienced.

## A. Seven preceding 40

In the Flood story, Breishit chapter 7

## B. . Manna – as preparation for Mount Sinai /Shmot chapter 16
