## The Failure of the First Generation - Part #3 Why (possibly) Moshe and Aharon are to blame

#### Intro:

We are all familiar with the famous story of 'Moshe & the Rock' - and his tragic punishment - that he couldn't enter the Land of Israel.

In today's shiur, we re-examine the details of that event, in light of previous events in Sefer Devarim - in an attempt to better understand the logic of God's harsh decision.
