Class #9 - Yirmiyahu's career - A 'success' or a 'failure'?

#### Intro:

We dedicate our final class of this 9 part series to reflect on how to view Yirmiyahu's career as a prophet, including his affect on his own generation, on the next generation, and on future generations:

Our primary focus will be on the "nechama" in chapters 31->33

### I. Yirimiyahu's own assessment - chapter 20
